Active and Passive Voice Voice refers to the form of a verb that indicates when a grammatical subject performs the action or is the receiver of the action When a sentence is written in the active voice, the subject performs the action; in the passive voice, the subject receives the action In academic writing, it

ACTIVE vs PASSIVE VOICE Problem Beginning or inattentive writers tend to overuse passive voice, which can weaken their prose, lead to the omission of important information, and make them appear unsure of their ideas When instructors draw attention to the problem, some students overcompensate, eliminating all passive voice from their writing

Choosing Active Voice In most nonscientific writing situations, active voice is preferable to passive for the majority of your sentences Even in scientific writing, overuse of passive voice or use of passive voice in long and complicated sentences can cause readers to lose interest or to become confused
