2 Individual employment regulation a) Employment contracts Contracts concluded for an indefinite duration are the rule and fixed term employment contracts are the exception The latter are only valid when all conditions provided for by the law are fulfilled Employment contracts for a fixed duration may not exceed 24 months (including renewal)
